Changes in food regulations, consumer expectations and new processing options provide the food industry with new choices. Equipment manufacturers are faced with the need to develop new processing equipment, based on processes developed in the laboratory and sometimes pilot plants. The processing leaves the food product more vulnerable to microbial spoilage and consequently, hygienic requirements become more stringent.

EFFoST and EHEDG decided to join efforts and resources in this conference because of the need for interdisciplinary co-operation: processing is impossible without equipment and the resulting food products must fulfil all expectations with respect to quality and safety.

- Filling and packaging
- New food contact materials
- Regulations, verification and validation
